

The **SMRT Community Emergency Preparedness (SCEP)** Programme aims to train and equip the community to play a more effective role in public transport safety and security.

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

All SCEP participants will undergo three hours of theory and four hours of practical lessons.

✓ The theory lesson includes:

- Introduction to security threats and challenges such as chemical, biological, radiological and explosive attacks
- Training on how to be vigilant on SMRT's transport network
- Training on reporting procedures and emergency response

✓ The practical training lesson comprises on-site role-playing, identification and reporting of threats, and a train evacuation using the detainment ramp.

✓ SCEP training lessons are conducted fortnightly, subject to a minimum class size of 50 persons.

✓ SCEP graduates may take part in any upcoming Emergency Preparedness Exercise held at the stations, train depot or bus interchange (optional).

Objectives

The SMRT Community Emergency Preparedness (SCEP) Programme ("the Programme") seeks to:

- Educate and train the community, so as to increase safety and security awareness in both rail and bus systems
- Equip the community to play a more effective role in identifying and reporting suspicious looking persons / items and potential threats.
- Ensure that the community knows what to do in the event of an emergency, so that they can help themselves and others

The Application Terms and Conditions - Eligibility

- The SCEP Programme is open to all Singapore residents / Permanent Residents who are at least 13 years old.
- Each application will be subjected to a selection process for participation, which will be conducted by SMRT Corporation Ltd (the "Organiser"). Upon submission of the application form to the Organiser, it is deemed that the applicant agrees to abide by:
 - (a) all the Terms and Conditions of the application process to participate in the Programme;
 - (b) all the Terms and Conditions of the indemnities, releases and waivers in the Application and Declaration Form attached herein;
 - (c) any other requirements as determined by the Organiser from time to time
- The applicant's compliance with all the Terms and Conditions does not guarantee selection for participation in the Programme. The Organiser further reserves the right to suspend, discontinue or terminate the Programme at any time, at its absolute discretion, without prior notice, and without any liability whatsoever.
