Greener buses

Starting May 2008, our new fleet of 67 Euro V buses will be put into service – the first for a public transport service provider in Singapore and South East Asia.

These buses are wheelchair-friendly and meet the higher Euro V emission standards, with a 42 per cent reduction in harmful nitrous oxide pollutants compared to Euro IV buses.

Our new buses will also be equipped with BlueTec® SCR Engine Technology, which converts harmful nitrous oxide emissions into mostly nitrogen and water vapour, making emission from the buses cleaner and safer.

Cleaner alternative to diesel powered taxis

Delivery of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) taxis is also underway. SMRT Taxis will progressively add 200 CNG taxis to its fleet. CNG vehicles emit little or no fine particulates, sulphur dioxide, carbon monoxide, hydrocarbons and oxides of nitrogen, making them cleaner alternatives to diesel powered vehicles.

Another positive feature is that CNG vehicles produce lower noise levels than diesel vehicles, making them quieter to operate – a plus for our urban living environment.

Another 100 new taxis which meet the Euro IV emission standards will also be introduced.
