Circle Line Extension – train service information

Peak period

(Mon – Fri: 7.30am - 9.30am; 5.30 pm – 7.30pm; Sat: 12.00noon to 2.00pm)

- Frequency: 3.5min (HarbourFront to Promenade); 7 mins (Esplanade, Bras Basah, Dhoby Ghaut, Bayfront, Marina Bay)
- Trains from HarbourFront will travel alternatively to terminate at Dhoby Ghaut and Marina Bay terminal stations (indicated by '8' and '10' for direction of travel – please refer to system map on next page).
- Passengers should check the passenger information screens at platform for the train's terminating station.

Off-peak period

- Frequency: 7min (HarbourFront to Stadium; Esplanade, Bras Basah, Dhoby Ghaut, Bayfront and Marina Bay); 3.5mins (Stadium, Nicoll Highway, Promenade)
- All train service from HarbourFront will terminate at Dhoby Ghaut terminal station.
- A shuttle train service to Circle Line Extension will operate between Stadium and Marina Bay stations (ie. shuttle service will call at Stadium, Nicoll Highway, Promenade, Bayfront and Marina Bay stations).

Useful Tips

Passengers travelling from HarbourFront to Bayfront and Marina Bay stations should:

- Transfer to the Circle Line Extension shuttle service at Stadium, Nicoll Highway or Promenade stations and take the shuttle train service to Bayfront and Marina Bay.
- Passenger transferring at Promenade station will arrive at upper platform (Platform B).
- They should remain at Platform B to wait for the shuttle train, and check the passenger information screen at the platform before boarding the train – the screen should say "Marina Bay", and "10" for direction of travel.

Passengers travelling from Dhoby Ghaut and transferring to the Circle Line Extension at Promenade station should note:

- They will arrive at the lower platform of the station (Platform A). After alighting, they should take the escalator that brings them to Platform B.
- Wait for the train at Platform B.
- Check the passenger information screen at the platform before boarding the train – the screen should say "Marina Bay" and "10" for direction of travel.

All passengers should check the passenger information screens at platform for the train's terminating station before boarding.
