Key Elements of the 2018 SMRT Trains Uniform Designs

Comfort

Lighter and absorbent material that is wrinkle free, comfortable and easy to maintain. For example, the new t-shirts for maintenance staff uses absorbent cotton as they spend a lot of time outdoors.

Functionality

Many practical features have been incorporated into the new designs. Examples include pants and skorts which have a loop at the sides for stations staff to hang their radio sets, freeing up their hands for work, and Train Captain's pants also have a side leg pocket for them to keep notes such as schedules, and is easily accessible while sitting down.

Flexibility

For frontline staff, the men's shirt and ladies' blouse both come in long sleeve and short sleeve options, while ladies have the choice of pairing their blouses with pants

or skorts, depending on their preference. Staff will be also be equipped with a smart, bright red jacket to keep warm in air-conditioned environment.

<u>Safety</u>

Uniforms for technicians and maintenance personnel have a grey base colour as it conceals stains better. It comes with bright red accents on the front and back of the sleeves and pants to enhance visibility for safety.

Details of Different Uniform Types

Frontline Personnel

- MRT station managers and service ambassadors, train captains and operations controllers
- Top (shirt / blouse) in cool grey and white stripes, with red accents at the colour sleeve and collars with fine prints of the SMRT logo (roundel)
- The ladies' blouse has a soft, feminine scoop neckline, with the option of being paired with 'skorts'
- Bottom (pants / skorts) in charcoal grey with pockets and loops for keys and radio loops
- Fabric is a mix of Terylene and Rayon for comfort and easy care, with only light ironing required

<u>Technicians and Maintenance Personnel</u>

- Top (t-shirt) in charcoal grey with red accents around the sleeves at the side of the shirt
- Bottom (cargo pants) in charcoal grey with side and back pockets, with velcro fastening. Pockets come with red accents.
- Material is made of Terylene and Cotton

Corporate Polo t-shirts

- Base colour is charcoal grey, with red accents around the collar and at the sleeves and side of the shirt
- SMRT logo (roundel) at the front of the shirt
- Collar can be worn open or fully zipped up
- Material is made of Polyester
